See attached roster. Chapter President Gene Gudenkauf called the meeting to order at 1210 hours.

INTRODUCTIONS:

LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS: Daniel London reported on recent legislative activities, i.e.: The Senate adjourned until 13 September without passing the NDAA., hopefully they will vote on return and then it will have to be reconciled with the House version before passage; The 2010 Disaster/War Supplemental bill has been signed into law by President Obama; The Stop-Loss compensation program will end in just a few months with only 25,000 entitled to compensation have received it. Senator Lautenberg has requested DoD Secretary Gates to provide specific information on the Department's efforts to reach 145,000 others who may be entitled to these benefits.
