

**FORT KNOX CHAPTER, AUSA**  
**Executive Council Meeting**

13 January 2010

**ATTENDANCE**

See attached roster. Gene Gudenkauf called the meeting to order at approximately 12:00 hours. Gudenkauf welcomed and thanked all for their presence. He also made note of and congratulated Kendra Stewart for her election as President of the Radcliff-North Hardin Chamber of Commerce and Rik Hawkins for his appointment as President-Executive Director of the Elizabethtown Chamber of Commerce.

**INTRODUCTIONS:** All attendees were asked to do a self introduction with COL Mike Snowden, DCG, USAAC, being our latest new attendee.

**MINUTES AND ACTIVITY REPORTS**

There were 11 military and 18 civilians for a total of 29 present at the 13 January 2010 Executive Council Meeting. The minutes for December were reviewed and approved. Financial reports for December will be presented in February as our Treasurer is currently on vacation.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** See above.

**COMMUNICATIONS/REQUESTS:** None presented.

**GENERAL BUSINESS**

**AWARDS:** Bob Roush reported that the chapter will be participating in the Post Awards Ceremony on Feb. 5, 2010 and that chapter will provide door prizes for the Armor Ball on February 6, 2010 at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, Louisville.

**LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS:** Daniel London gave an update on the FY10 Defense Appropriations Bill that President Obama signed into law on December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2009 (see attached).

**MEMBERSHIP REPORT:** The end of month December membership report was included in the meeting packet. It was noted that December produced a loss of 18 members bringing us down to 1,304 members and that our quarterly goal is 1,350. It was also noted that Active Duty membership at 313 was less than 10% of the authorized strength of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Bde, 1<sup>st</sup> ID and certainly not a good percentage of all units/commands on post.

Discussion ensued on the past practice of the chapter or a corporate member sponsor paying for up to 100 junior memberships [E-4 and below] at a cost of \$12.00 each. It was suggested that these memberships may not give us the return on investment that we might desire and that perhaps we should consider full memberships at \$25.00 each for individuals in the E5 - E7 and GS5 - GS6 range. After some discussion it was decided that the chapter should test this idea with up to 50 new memberships during the year.

**PROGRAMS:** COL Davidson provided an AAR on the AUSA Annual Meeting from an Armor Center perspective (see attached).

**RETIREE'S:** CSM (Ret) Don Devine provided dates and times for the upcoming Retiree Council and PX/Commissary meetings.

**CONTRACTORS, NCO & ENLISTED AFFAIRS:** CSM (Ret) George DeSario recommended that we form a committee to do something special for the upcoming Armor Conference since it will be the last one to be held at Fort Knox. President Gudenkauf took this on as an action item.

### **SUB-CHAPTER REPORTS**

**16<sup>th</sup> CAV:** COL Quintas reported that 16<sup>th</sup> CAV courses are up to capacity and again reminded us of the upcoming Armor Ball on February 6, 2010 at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, Louisville.

**GARRISON:** Connie Shaffery reported that the Bingo Hall adjacent to the Patton Museum will be opening tomorrow, January 14<sup>th</sup>.

**3ESC:** COL (P) Akin reported that she would be attending the AUSA Winter Symposium in February in Fort Lauderdale.

**3<sup>rd</sup> BDE, 1<sup>st</sup> ID:** COL Toner reported that the Brigade will be at 3400+ by June. Currently there 800 Soldiers residing in barracks, 500 Soldiers and families living on post and 1,000 Soldiers and their families living out in the community. The Brigade has already conducted over 60 Mobile Training Teams.

**BBB:** Cathy Williamson reported on her activities on post regarding the Better Business Bureau. She advised that some incoming Soldiers have apparently made some bad decisions regarding housing. She cautioned that we should advise Soldiers to be very careful about taking information found on the internet at face value and that they should perform the necessary investigation of credentials with the BBB, Chambers of Commerce and other local sources.

**ARMY ACCESSIONS COMMAND:** COL Snowden reported that the new HRC headquarters building is 94% complete with work currently being done on the IT setup.

**COMMAND GROUP:** COL Teeples, DCO, expressed MG Milano's gratitude for all the good things our chapter does for Soldiers and their families.

Gene then expressed the chapters appreciation to COL Teeples for his support over the years and wished him the very best in his new assignment.

Adjourn. There being no further business, Gudenkauf adjourned the meeting at approximately 1245. Our next meeting will be held on 10 Feb 2010 at the Fort Knox Leader's Club.
